1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:04 p.m.

  - a) R2016-0122: A Resolution making a Cuyahoga County 9-1-1 Consolidation Shared Services Fund award to City of South Euclid on behalf of Heights/Hillcrest Communications Center in the amount notto-exceed \$1,000,000.00 for Public Safety Answering Point consolidation support for the period 8/1/2016 - 8/1/2017; authorizing the County Executive to execute the agreement and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and

declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Brandy Carney, Director of the Department of Public Safety and Justice Services; Mr. Edward Kraus, Director of the Department of Regional Collaboration; Mr. Kevin Niehert, Chief of Police for the City of South Euclid; and Mr. Frank Bova, Chief Community Safety and Protection Officer, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2016-0122.
