Chairman Tuma called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Lutke Investment Properties, LLC fka Investment Properties, Ltd. for lease of office space and parking spaces located at 1835/1849 Prospect Avenue, Cleveland, for use by Cuyahoga County Veterans Service Commission for the period 10/1/2009 -9/30/2019 to extend the time period to 9/30/2024 and for additional funds in the \$1,050,000.00; amount not-to-exceed authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

WHEREAS, the County Executive/Department of Public Works on behalf of Cuyahoga County Veterans Service Commission has recommended an amendment to Contract No. CE0900320-02 with Terry L. Poltorek Kenneth F. Lutke Partners Investment Properties, LLC fka Investment Properties, Ltd. for lease of office space and parking spaces located at 1835/1849 Prospect Avenue, Cleveland, for use by Cuyahoga County Veterans Service Commission for the period 10/1/2009 - 9/30/2019 to extend the time period to 9/30/2024 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,050,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the primary goal of this amendment is to extend the term of the original Lease for an additional five (5) years at a decreased rent of \$14.50 per square foot; and

WHEREAS, this project is funded 100% by the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

**SECTION 1.** That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby authorizes an amendment to Contract No. CE0900320-02 with Terry L. Poltorek Kenneth F. Lutke Partners Investment Properties, LLC fka Investment Properties, Ltd. for lease of office space and parking spaces located at 1835/1849 Prospect Avenue, Cleveland, for use by Cuyahoga County Veterans Service Commission for the period 10/1/2009 - 9/30/2019 to extend the time period to 9/30/2024 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,050,000.00.

**SECTION 2.** That the County Executive is authorized to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution.

**SECTION 3.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public peace, health or safety in the County; and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
